# Invitation to Peer Review Cancer of Unknown Primary Services

This new team and programme has been developed to meet the requirements of the new health care environment and national specialised commissioning directorate. The purpose of the Quality Surveillance Team (QST) is to improve the quality and outcomes of clinical services by delivering a sustainable and embedded quality assurance programme for all cancer services and specialised commissioned services within NHS England.

We are recruiting doctors, nurses, managers and patients and carers who will provide valuable experience and knowledge when reviewing Cancer of Unknown Primary (CUP) services. We will be reviewing services against the CUP measures that can be found on [www.cquins.nhs.uk](http://www.cquins.nhs.uk). This is the first comprehensive review cycle of CUP services, therefore it is imperative that we have fully functional review teams on each visit.

In order to become a reviewer we ask that you attend one of our national training events which will be taking place over the next 6 months and to commit to at least one review visit.

Expenses will be reimbursed and overnight accommodation will be made available for morning review visits.
