#### International World CUP Alliance Meeting - October 2025



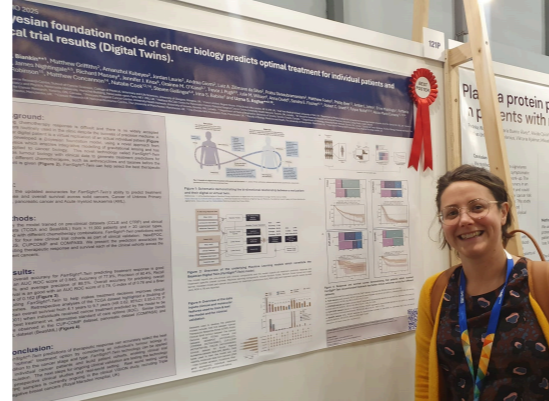
The World CUP Alliance hosted its first International CUP hybrid conference in Berlin, with 180 attendees from 29 countries and 5 continents.

Sessions included Molecular Profiling in the Precision Oncology Era, Patient Experience and Collaborations in CUP, and Treatment, Research and Imaging in CUP. A conference proceedings have been written up and we will share once published.
